




Receiver front panel function introduction



- Rack mount kit: fixed installation;
- LCD display: System settings and parameters;
- Infrared (IR) window: send infrared signal to the transmitter, in order to realize the synchronization;
- SYNC button: Press the "SYNC" button, synchronization of transmitters via IR interface from receiver;
- ⑤ "◄", "▶" allow control button: press the allow button to edit the menu parameter values;
- **6** "SET" button: press to enter or select the menu;
- Power switch: turn on the receiver of power supply, long press to turn off the receiver;
- Ochannel button: this 1/2/3/4 buttons, press to enter the current independent channel setting parameters or exit menu;
- AB antenna display;
- AF signal display;


- RF signal display:
- ALERT alarm;
- 1/2 wavelength BNC antenna: used to receive radio transmitter for transmission.

Receiver rear panel function introduction




- The ac power input: IEC connector, 110-240V AC;
- RF antenna input connector: BNC connectors, apply to receive radio signals, and to support the DC 12V/150 mA power output;
- SF antenna output connector: suitable for more than one receiver use, provide RF signal to other receiver;
- Ethernet port/ Dante network: Connect to Ethernet to transmit Dante digital audio and control signals for audio distribution, monitoring and recording - Reference "Dante network" theme;
- **6** LIFT/GND switch: control XLR pin 1 whether is contact GND;
- Main audio balance OUTPUT socket (MIXER OUTPUT): XLR card socket, all channel audio can be output here;
- Single channel audio balance OUTPUT socket (BALANCED OUT): Output each channel of audio separately.

Handheld transmitter function instruction




- The microphone cartridge: used to pick up the audio to the transmitter modulation:
- Q OLED display: display frequency, group, channels, battery life, etc;
- Open Power supply switches, turn the power on or off;
- Infrared (IR) window: synchronization of transmitters via IR interface from receiver:
- SELECT" button: press the button to edit the menu parameter values:
- 6 Menu setting button: press to enter or confirm the setting;
- Battery cover: When installing, replacing or setting the infrared frequency, the battery cover must be opened;
- Handheld transmitter tail cover: integrated antenna transmit output port;
- 9 Battery holder: Install 2 AA batteries.


Bodypack transmitter function instruction




- φ 3.5mm with nut lock antenna: For transmitting a bodypack radio carrier;
- Infrared (IR) window: Aligning the infrared port of the receiver allows the transmitter to synchronize with the receiver frequency during infrared synchronization;
- 3 OLED display: display frequency, group, channel, battery life, etc;
- MINI 4-pin audio input socket;
- **6** Light touch power switch: turn the power on or off;
- Oress to enter or confirm the setting;
- Press the button to edit the menu parameter values;
- Bodypack holder: used to fix the bodypack on the clothes;
- Battery cover: When installing, replacing or setting the infrared frequency, the battery cover must be opened;
- Battery holder: Install 2 AA batteries.

Receiver device installation









Multiple receivers connected to the RF distribution port

The RF distribution port can transmit RF signals from one receiver to the next, allowing up to 5 receivers to share a pair of antennas. Connect the ports of each receiver using the supplied RF distribution cable as shown below.




(Note: all receivers must be operating in the same frequency band.)

Handheld microphone battery installation




Bodypack transmitter battery installation




Simple operation step

1. After connecting the antenna and the power cable, press the power button to turn on the receiver. When the display is lit, the power is turned on successfully.




2. Press and hold the receiver "SET" button to enter the menu setting;






3. Press the corresponding channel button, then short press "SET" to enter the channel mode setting; (as shown below)




4. Automatic frequency scan: After selecting the channel button, press the "SET" button to enter the automatic scan function (AFS), and then select "Auto-scan group" / "Auto-scan channel" will appear the automatic scan interface. (As shown below)







The scan channel automatically calculates a free frequency, and the "RF" light on the receiver indicator does not illuminate; if not, repeat this action until the clean channel is scanned.



5. The transmitter's infrared window facing to the receiver IR port. Press the "Sync" button.



The frequency of the transmitter and the receiver are synchronized. When talking with the microphone, the "AF" signal in the display jumps to indicate that there is an audio output.




Channel display (receiver and transmitter display the same frequency)

Safety operation and Notice
